Dear GeSuS Members and Friends,

This year, GeSuS can look back on the 30-year history of its conferences, known as GeSuS Linguistics Study Days (GeSuS-Linguistiktage). The organizers of the 30th anniversary conference are very delighted to invite all members and friends of GeSuS to the conference at Adam Mickiewicz University, scheduled for June 24-26, 2024. The theme of this conference is "Europe and the Diversity of its Languages."

We would particularly welcome **contributions** addressing topics related to the European language mosaic, such as individual and collective multilingualism, language didactics, discourse analysis, translation studies, corpus linguistics, cultural linguistics etc. Interdisciplinary approaches to the researched phenomena are highly encouraged. Traditionally, we also invite discussions that are situated within established linguistic domains such as phonetics/phonology, morphology, syntax, semantics, historical, and contrastive linguistics. Moreover, as always, workshops and presentations on all current topics in linguistics and language didactics are warmly welcome.

The **conference languages** are German, French, English, and Polish. However, in line with the conference theme, GeSuS Linguistics Conference encourages linguistic diversity. Therefore, we are looking forward to parallel lectures and presentations; however, they should cover at least one of the main conference languages, i.e. for example, presentation slides in English with a spoken presentation in Polish, or handouts in French with a spoken presentation in German.

We're assuming an **in-person event**, but individual workshops have the option to organize in a hybrid format.

Abstracts and Deadlines

You can submit proposals for workshops with a brief description (appr. 400 words) until 15. March 2024.

Presentations (20 minutes presentation plus 10 minutes discussion time) or posters with a short abstract (appr. 400 words, including references) should be registered by 30. April 2024. Please send both a Word file and a PDF to the local organizational address **gesus2024@amu.edu.pl**. The notification of acceptance is usually provided within a few days by the workshop leadership.

Please submit any cancellations by 25. May 2024; unfortunately, no conference fee refunds are possible after this date.
